Phylicia attended Committee on Special Education (CSE) meetings, accompanied the family on tours of alternative placement settings, and answered all of Jennifer's questions.

"Phylicia is awesome. She understands and is willing to go the extra mile. She's been amazing helping me work with the school system, to make it work the way it's supposed to."

All Kaitlynn wants is the public education she deserves. With Phylicia's help, she was moved to a day treatment setting that is better able to meet her needs. Kaitlynn is thriving, and hopes to finish school and move on to post-secondary education. The help of an educational advocate will make this possible.

At the LDA of WNY, we believe that every individual, even those with disabilities, can be successful at school, at work, in relationships, and in the community. Our goal is to ensure such opportunities exist.
